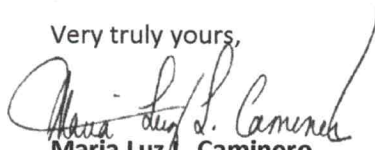

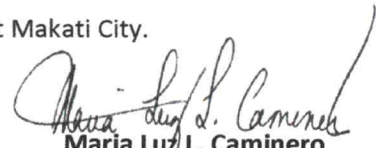
Deed of Undertaking
